

CAP. XXXII.

An Act to amend article 2320 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, respecting the judges of the Superior Court.

[Assented to 2nd April, 1890.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Paragraph 2 of article 2320 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec is replaced by the following : R. S. Q., art. 2320 amended.
- “ 2. The judge, to whom the district of Montmagny is assigned, likewise exercises his ordinary functions in the district of Beauce, with his residence in the city of Montmagny is also judge of Beauce.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CAP. XXXIII.

An Act to amend article 2507 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, respecting district magistrates.

[Assented to 2nd April, 1890.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2507 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec is replaced by the following : R. S. Q., art. 2507 replaced.

“ 2507. Each such magistrate is allowed an annual salary not exceeding the sum of twelve hundred dollars ; however, in places where the increase of business justifies it, he may be allowed a larger salary, but not exceeding the sum of three thousand dollars per annum. Salaries of district magistrates.

Such salary is fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, and is paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund.” How fixed and paid.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
