CAP. LXXXIII.

An Act to amend "The act incorporating the Trustees of the American Presbyterian Society of Montreal."

[Assented to 2nd April, 1890.]

WHEREAS, "The Trustees of the American Presby- ^{Preamble.}
terian Society of Montreal", a body politic and corporate, incorporated under a statute of the Province of Canada, passed in the session held in the 27th and 28th years of Her Majesty's reign, have by their petition prayed for certain amendments to the said act of incorporation, and it is expedient to grant such prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 14 of the said act of incorporation (27-28 ^{37-28 Vict., c.}
Victoria, chapter 163) is hereby repealed and replaced by ^{163, s. 14,}
the following: _{replaced.}

"14. An annual general meeting of the said congregation shall be held on such date in each year, as the said corporation may by by-law appoint, in the building used by the said congregation as a place of worship, notice of which meeting shall be given from the pulpit of said church during service on Sunday, at least four days before the day appointed for such general meeting; and besides the power of election hereinafter specified, the said congregation may, at such annual meeting, exercise all the powers conferred upon it by this act, and shall be competent for the transaction of business generally." ^{Annual general meeting of the congregation.}
