

CAP. II.

An Act respecting the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

WHEREAS since the 11th May, 1887, date of the sanc- Preamble.
tioning of the act 50 Victoria, chapter 5, respecting the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, the corrections, additions and changes have been made to the printed roll marked A, in accordance with sections 1 and 2 of the said act 50 Victoria, chapter 5 ;

Whereas, before depositing the printed roll in the office of the Clerk of the Legislature, and issuing the proclamation to put the said Revised Statutes into force, in accordance with sections 3 and 4 of the said act, it is expedient to incorporate therewith the statutes of a general nature passed during this Session ; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Lieutenant-Governor may select such acts and parts of acts passed during the present session as he may deem advisable to incorporate with the roll marked A, mentioned in the act 50 Victoria, chapter 5, as being that of the statutes revised, classified and consolidated, and may incorporate them therewith, adapting their form and language to those of the said statutes, but without changing their legal effect, inserting them in their proper places in the said statutes, striking out of the latter any enactments repealed by or inconsistent with those so incorporated, altering the numbering of the titles, chapters, sections, paragraphs and articles or their order, if need be, and adding to the Appendix A of the said act, after the list of the acts and parts of acts of last session which was added thereto, a list of the acts and parts of acts of this session incorporated as aforesaid. Insertion of acts of this session in roll.

2. So soon as the said incorporation of such acts and parts of acts and the said additions to and changes to be made in the said Appendix A, have been completed, the Lieutenant-Governor may cause a printed Roll thereof, attested under his signature and countersigned by the Provincial Secretary, to be deposited in the office of the Clerk of the Legislature, which roll shall be held to the original thereof, and to embody so much of the several acts and parts of acts mentioned as repealed in the amended Appendix A thereto annexed. Deposit of certified roll comprising the acts of this session and the modifications to Appendix A.

3. This act shall be considered as an amendment of the act 50 Victoria, chapter 5, of which it shall only be the Act considered as

corollary, and consequently the two acts shall form but one act, and shall be interpreted as being one and the same act.

4. The Revised Statutes shall have one series of articles throughout, and may be cited by the number of the article, adding the words "Of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec."

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CAP. III.

An Act to provide for the replacing of destroyed originals of the Statutes.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the burning of the legislative buildings of Quebec, in 1883, destroyed all the originals of the Statutes of the Province of Quebec, which had been placed in the care of the Clerk of the Legislative Council, and it is necessary to provide for their being replaced, as also the replacing of those which may hereafter be destroyed;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Clerk of the Legislature is, by this act, authorized to procure from the Queen's printer, upon the order of the Provincial Secretary, a series of bound volumes of the Statutes of the Province of Quebec, printed by the said Queen's printer, up to the nineteenth of April, 1883, date of the destruction of the originals of the said statutes, by the burning of the legislative buildings of Quebec, to serve as originals to replace those so destroyed;—and to procure them in the same manner, whenever the original of the statutes deposited in his office have been destroyed by fire or otherwise.

2. Copies of the statutes so deposited, certified under the signature of the Clerk of the Legislature, are authentic and make proof of such statutes and of the contents thereof, as if they were true copies of the originals destroyed.

3. The certificate of the Clerk of the Legislature upon the copies of the said statutes shall read as follows:
