

## CAP. XL.

An Act to amend the act 47 Victoria, chapter 23, respecting industrial schools.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

47 V., c. 23, s. 1, § 12, replaced.

**1.** Subsection numbered 12 of section 1 of the act 47 Victoria, chapter 23, is replaced by the following :

Child under 12 being an orphan may be brought before justices of the peace, &c.

“ 12. Two rate-payers of any municipality may cause to be brought before two justices of the peace or a magistrate, any child under the age of twelve years, who is fatherless or motherless and whose surviving parent misconducts himself or whose parents are criminals condemned to the penitentiary, and who, in either case, is without any means of subsistence, and has no relative legally liable for his support.”

**2.** Subsection numbered 15 of the said section is amended by striking out in the fourth and fifth lines the words “ between the age of seven and twelve years,” and replacing them by the words “under twelve years of age.”

Coming into force.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## CAP. XLI.

An Act to amend the act 49-50 Victoria, chapter 34 respecting the Bar of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

49-50 V., c. 34, s. 96, amended.

**1.** Section 96 of the said act is amended by striking out the second paragraph thereof, and replacing it by the following words :

Approval of tariffs.

“ The tariffs shall be forwarded to the Lieutenant-Governor in council and shall come into force only with his approval.”
