3. The corporation shall have the same rights as private individuals, with regard to real estate; provided the annual revenue thereof does not exceed two thousand dollars.

An Act to incorporate *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres*.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* have established themselves, as a religious community, in the city of Montreal, with the authorization of the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Montreal, and have, by their petition, prayed to be incorporated; and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Mother Anna Catherine Corryne, Superioress of the said religious community, the Reverend Sister Félicité Hugon, Sylvie Leblanc, Pauline Anne Lutzmann, Marguerite Cortléry, Emma Diguam, Eugénie Meriot, members of the said religious community, and all other persons who may become members thereof, according to the rules of the community are hereby constituted a corporation under the name of *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* and shall, under such name, have perpetual succession and a common seal, which they may alter at will and appear before the courts as any person may do.

Name and

Power to hold,
&c., property.

2. The community of *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* may possess, accept and acquire by any legal title, moveable and immoveable property, which it may sell, alienate, hypothecate, transfer, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of under any title whatsoever, provided the annual revenue of the immoveables possessed by *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* for the purposes of this act shall not exceed twenty-five thousand dollars.

Amount limit-
ed.

3. *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* shall have their corporate seat in the city of Montreal, and may establish houses in different places in this Province in fulfilment of the objects of their incorporation. Head office.
Branch establishment.

The Board of Directresses may, nevertheless, meet in any other place which it may think proper. Meetings may be elsewhere than at head office.

4. *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* shall have power to make and pass by-laws, rules and regulations respecting the administration of the property, the management, internal government, election, number and power of the officers and directresses, the admission and withdrawal of members and generally all by-laws consistent with the laws of this Province. Power to pass by-laws for certain purposes.

5. *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* shall have a board of management, the quorum whereof shall be three, until another number be otherwise determined by by-law. Board of management.
Quorum.

The first board shall consist of the seven persons mentioned in the first section. The number may afterwards be changed by by-law. Number of members.

The Lady Superior of the community in the city of Montreal shall be, *ex-officio*, president of the board of management as long as she remains in office. President of board.

6. Only the persons who belong to the religious community known in the Roman Catholic Church as *Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* can be members of the corporation. Who may become member of the corporation.

7. The object which *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* have in view is : to provide a refuge during the remainder of their lives for old persons of both sexes who are poor or infirm, of respectable character, of at least sixty years of age, without distinction of creed or nationality. Objects of corporation.

8. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CAP. LVI.

An Act to amend the Act 23 Victoria, chapter 136 of the Statutes of the former Province of Canada, respecting *La Communauté des Filles de Ste. Anne*.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

WHEREAS *La Communauté des Filles de Ste. Anne*, has, by Preamble, petition, represented that it religiously fulfills the object of its foundation, that it has spread considerably throughout the Province; but that, in order to facilitate its
