

3. *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* shall have their corporate seat in the city of Montreal, and may establish houses in different places in this Province in fulfilment of the objects of their incorporation. Head office.
Branch establishment.

The Board of Directresses may, nevertheless, meet in any other place which it may think proper. Meetings may be elsewhere than at head office.

4. *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* shall have power to make and pass by-laws, rules and regulations respecting the administration of the property, the management, internal government, election, number and power of the officers and directresses, the admission and withdrawal of members and generally all by-laws consistent with the laws of this Province. Power to pass by-laws for certain purposes.

5. *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* shall have a board of management, the quorum whereof shall be three, until another number be otherwise determined by by-law. Board of management.
Quorum.

The first board shall consist of the seven persons mentioned in the first section. The number may afterwards be changed by by-law. Number of members.

The Lady Superior of the community in the city of Montreal shall be, *ex-officio*, president of the board of management as long as she remains in office. President of board.

6. Only the persons who belong to the religious community known in the Roman Catholic Church as *Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* can be members of the corporation. Who may become member of the corporation.

7. The object which *Les Petites Sœurs des Pauvres* have in view is : to provide a refuge during the remainder of their lives for old persons of both sexes who are poor or infirm, of respectable character, of at least sixty years of age, without distinction of creed or nationality. Objects of corporation.

8. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CAP. LVI.

An Act to amend the Act 23 Victoria, chapter 136 of the Statutes of the former Province of Canada, respecting *La Communauté des Filles de Ste. Anne*.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

WHEREAS *La Communauté des Filles de Ste. Anne*, has, by Preamble, petition, represented that it religiously fulfills the object of its foundation, that it has spread considerably throughout the Province; but that, in order to facilitate its

development, it requires more ample powers than those conferred upon it by its charter, and also that it desires to change its name to that of *La Communauté des Sœurs de Ste. Anne* ; and whereas, it is expedient to grant its prayer ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

23 V., c. 136, s. 1, replaced.

1. Section 1 of the Act of the late Province of Canada, 23 Victoria, chapter 136, is replaced by the following :

Persons incorporated.

" 1. Mesdames Eléonore Pivin, Salomé Veronneau, Angèle Giroux, Catherine Béfort, Sophie Saintonge, and Adelaïde Ledoux, and such other persons as are or shall, under the provisions of this act, become members of the said association, shall be, and are hereby declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the name of "*La Communauté des Sœurs de Sainte-Anne*" ;

Name.

Succession.

Seal.

By that name they shall have perpetual succession and a common seal, and shall have power, from time to time, to alter, renew or change such common seal at their pleasure.

Power to hold property.

They shall, by the same name, from time to time, and at all times hereafter, be able and capable to purchase, acquire, hold, possess and enjoy, and to have, take and receive, to them and their successors, to and for the uses and purposes of the corporation, any lands, tenements and hereditaments, and real or immoveable property and estate, within the Province of Quebec, not exceeding in yearly value, after payment of the costs of administration, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars for the principal establishment and two thousand dollars for each branch establishment ; and the same to hypothecate, sell, alienate and dispose of, and to purchase others in their stead for the same purpose.

Amount limited.

Power to sell, &c., real estate.

Powers of majority of administrative body to make by-laws.

Any majority of the members of the administrative body of the corporation, for the time being, shall have full power and authority to make and establish such rules, orders, and regulations, not being contrary to this act, nor to the laws in force in this Province, as shall be deemed useful or necessary for the interests of the corporation, and for the management thereof, and for the admission of members into the said corporation, and, from time to time, to alter, repeal and change the said rules, orders and regulations, or any of them, or those of the said association in force at the time of the passing of this act.

Other powers.

Such majority shall and may do, execute and perform all and singular other matters and things relating to the corporation, and the management thereof, or which shall or may appertain thereto ; subject, nevertheless, to the rules, regulations, stipulations and provisions hereinafter prescribed and established.

The corporation may accordingly establish its corporate seat and principal establishment in any place in the province it may deem proper, and it may found and establish, in different places in this Province, branch establishments for the purposes of its incorporation " Corporate seat. Branch establishment.

2. Section 4 of the said act is replaced by the following : Id. s. 4, replaced.

" 4. The council of the community of the *Sœurs de Ste. Anne*, may appoint such officers, attorneys or administrators as it may deem necessary for the internal government and proper administration of the property and affairs of the corporation both at the principal establishment and at the branch establishments of the corporation. Community may appoint officers, &c., for management of its affairs.

The *Communauté des Filles de Ste. Anne* is hereby authorized to keep in its principal establishment, not only registers for entering monastic vows but also registers of deaths, which shall be kept in accordance with the laws of this Province relating to registers of civil status; and the death of nuns of the said community only shall be registered therein. Community to keep registers of burial, in accordance with the law. Entries to be made therein.

From and after the passing of this act, the corporation shall be known as the "*Communauté des Sœurs de Sainte Anne*" and under such name it shall, in addition to the rights and powers conferred upon it by this act, have all the rights, powers, properties and obligations of "*La communauté des filles de Sainte-Anne*." Name of corporation changed. Powers.

Nevertheless, no legacy, donation, gift and which may hereafter be made to the said corporation, designating it by its former corporate name, shall be annulled or attacked through such defect, when the intention of the testators or donors shall be manifest." Proviso as to legacies, &c., under old name.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

An Act to amend and consolidate the Acts relating to the Young Men's Christian Association of the City of Montreal.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

WHEREAS the Young Men's Association of Montreal, Preamble.
incorporated by the act 34 Victoria, chapter 59, and amended by the acts 36 Victoria, chapter 63 and 48 Victoria, chapter 49, has by its petition, represented that it has purchased from the Montreal Auxiliary Bible Society, Canada Sunday School Union, and Religious Tract Society, all the rights and privileges secured to them by the said acts in
