

## CAP. CXI.

An Act to ratify and confirm certain resolutions of the municipal council of the village of Côte Saint Antoine, granting a commutation of the ordinary municipal taxes payable by the Montreal Amateur Athletic Association on its athletic grounds at Côte Saint Antoine.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS the Montreal Amateur Athletic Association, a body politic and corporate, and duly by law incorporated, has recently purchased certain immoveable property from the estate Hallowell and Messrs. Ward and Davis, situated in the municipality of the village of Côte Saint Antoine, to be used solely for athletic purposes; and more particularly known and described as parts of lots numbers fourteen hundred and fourteen and fourteen hundred and fifteen (1414 and 1415) on the official plan and book of reference for the parish of Montreal;

That the said association has recently petitioned the council of the said village for a commutation of the municipal taxes to be assessed on the said grounds for a nominal tax of one hundred dollars per annum.

That by resolution of the said council, passed on the second of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, a commutation of the ordinary annual municipal taxes on the said grounds while used solely for athletic purposes for an annual payment of one hundred dollars, was granted, provided no intoxicating liquors were sold on the grounds, and provided the association complied with the terms of a resolution of the council passed on the thirteenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, whereby it was resolved that commutation of taxes would only be granted provided the association paid the costs of any legislation required to ratify, confirm and declare legal and binding any resolutions of the said council granting such commutation of taxes;

And whereas the said corporation of the village of Côte Saint Antoine have prayed by their petition for an act ratifying and confirming, and declaring valid and legal the resolutions of the council of the village granting a commutation of taxation, and for authority to enter into and execute a notarial deed of agreement, embodying and defining the conditions under which the commutation of municipal taxes is granted;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The resolution of the municipal council, passed on the second day of February, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight, granting the Montreal Amateur Athletic Association a commutation of the ordinary annual municipal taxes to be assessed and payable on its athletic grounds, at Côte Saint Antoine, while used for athletic purposes, for an annual payment of one hundred dollars, provided no intoxicating liquors are sold on the grounds, the said grounds having been recently purchased from the estate Hallowell and Messrs Ward and Davis, and known as parts of lot number fourteen hundred and fourteen, and fourteen hundred and fifteen (1414 and 1415), on the official plan and book of reference for the parish of Montreal, is hereby ratified and confirmed to all intents and purposes, and declared valid and legal ; and also the resolution of the municipal council, passed on the thirteenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-six, hereinabove mentioned.

Resolution of council of village of Côte St. Antoine, commuting taxes upon Association grounds, ratified.

2. The Corporation of the Village of Côte Saint Antoine and the Montreal Amateur Athletic Association are hereby respectively authorized to execute a notarial deed of agreement embodying and defining the conditions under which such commutation of taxation is granted.

Deed may be entered into embodying conditions of exemption from taxation.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## CAP. CXII.

An Act confirming a certain deed of lease made by the city of Montreal to the Royal Victoria Hospital.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

WHEREAS Sir George Stephen, Baronet, and Sir Donald Alexander Smith, K. C. M. G., both of Montreal, in Canada, have endowed the Royal Victoria Hospital of Montreal, a body corporate and politic, duly incorporated, with the sum of one million dollars ;

Preamble.

Whereas the corporation of the city of Montreal has leased to the said corporation of the Royal Victoria Hospital, by a deed of lease, made, bearing date, and executed at Montreal aforesaid, the 17th day of September last, before O. Marin, notary public, a certain property in Montreal aforesaid, in perpetuity, for a nominal rental of one dollar per annum, as a site for the said hospital, such lease, however, being subject to confirmation by the Legislature of the Province of Quebec ;
