

CAP. CXXI.

An Act to authorize The Grey Nuns of the General Hospital of Montreal to sell a lot of land in the parish of St. Joseph of Chambly.

[Assented to 12th July, 1888.]

WHEREAS, by the will of the late Clémence Sabatté, Preamble. received November 24th, 1858, the Grey Nuns of the General Hospital of Montreal, have been instituted her universal legatees, with the obligation of discharging certain legacies and of employing the balance of her moveable and immoveable property for the establishment and support of a house of charity in the village of Chambly Basin, and they have become owners of the said property by the death of the testatrix which occurred on the 21st of August, 1868 ;

Whereas all the legacies have been paid off, and the said charitable establishment has been in operation, giving general satisfaction, since the 22nd of April, 1869 ;

Whereas it has become necessary to rebuild the chapel of the said establishment on account of its deterioration ;

Whereas one half of the undivided northern extremity of the western three arpents lot of land No. 270 in the parish of St. Joseph of Chambly, measuring about eighteen arpents in superficies, which was part of the immoveables of the testatrix, and though it cannot be farmed directly by the said Nuns, would be, if it were sold, a great help for the rebuilding of the said chapel and thereby be a source of better income and contribute more efficaciously to the end aimed at by the testatrix ; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Grey Nuns of the General Hospital of Montreal are, by the present act, authorized to sell their undivided half of the said lot for the sum that they may deem advantageous, on the condition that they will employ the amount of the said sale for the rebuilding of the chapel of their establishment in the village of Chambly Basin. Certain lot of land authorized to be sold.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
