

CAP. VIII.

An act to amend chapter 79 of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting the Circuit Court.

[Assented to 21st June, 1886.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. S. L. C., c. 79, s. 7, amended.
Circuit Court may be held at more than one place in Beauharnois.

1. Section 7 of chapter 79 of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, as amended by the act 32 Victoria, chapter 21, is further amended by adding, after the word "Beauce" in the said section 7, the word "Beauharnois."

CAP. IX.

An Act to abolish the Circuit Court sitting at Ste. Croix, in the County of Lotbinière.

[Assented to 21st June, 1886.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is in the public interest to abolish the Circuit Court sitting at Ste. Croix, in the county of Lotbinière ; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Court abolished.

1. The Circuit Court sitting at Ste. Croix, in the county of Lotbinière, is hereby abolished.

Transfer of records, &c.

2. The registers, records, archives and proceedings of the said Circuit Court shall, within the delay fixed by order of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, be transferred to the *chef-lieu* of the district of Quebec.

Continuance of proceedings.

3. After the transmission of such documents, all proceedings, already had before the Circuit Court sitting at Ste. Croix, may be continued at the said *chef-lieu* of the district of Quebec, as if they were had and commenced at such latter place.
