

CAP. XXXV.

An Act to amend the act 45 Victoria, chapter 16, respecting land surveyors of the Province of Quebec, and the survey of lands.

[Assented to 21st June, 1886.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

45 V., c. 16,
s. 14, § 5,
amended.

1. Paragraph 5 of section 14 of the act 45 Victoria, chapter 16, is amended by striking out in the third line thereof the words "entrance as a member of the corporation" and substituting therefor the words "practising as a land surveyor."

2. Section 37 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :

Fee to be paid
by candidate
on again pre-
senting himself
for examina-
tion.

"In case the candidate should fail in his examination, he may present himself at any future examination, by paying, whenever he may so present himself, a fee of five dollars."

3. Section 39 of the said act is amended,

1. By striking out, in the first, second and third lines of the first paragraph thereof, the words : "Every land surveyor duly admitted in any of Her Majesty's dominions or possessions other than this province," and by replacing them by the following :

Admission of
surveyors from
other places.

"Every person admitted as a land surveyor for the Dominion of Canada or for any of the provinces of the said Dominion, other than that of Quebec, and in which there is a Board lawfully authorized for the admission of land surveyors, and who holds a diploma from such board" ;

2. By inserting after the words "the same," in the sixth line of the said first paragraph, the following words :

Proviso.

"Provided always that such board grants the same privileges to land surveyors holding diplomas in the province of Quebec" ;

3. By striking out the second paragraph of the said section.

4. Section 42 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following subsection :

Penalty for
practising for
payment when
not authorized.

"2. Every person who, for any reward, indemnity, payment or profit whatever, acts as, or exercises any of the functions of, a land surveyor of the province of Quebec, without being duly authorized to practise as such, is liable to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars.

Such fine is recoverable, with costs, before any court of competent jurisdiction, and is paid into the hands of the secretary of the board, to form part of the funds of the corporation." Fine how recoverable.

5. Section 52 of the said act is amended by striking out, in the fifth line thereof, the words "for such purposes," and substituting therefor the following words "for all surveying purposes." Id., s. 52 amended.

6. Section 57 of the said act is amended by inserting in the third line thereof, after the words "boundary marks of stone," the following words "or cast metal monuments of not less than four inches in diameter or iron monuments of not less than two inches in diameter." Id. s. 57, amended. Metal monuments, &c.

7. Section 60 of the said act is amended by inserting after the words "land surveyor," in the first line of the first paragraph thereof, the words "if he plants any boundary marks." Id., s. 60, amended. Proviso.

8. Section 61 of the said act is amended :

1. By adding after the words "last section," in the first clause thereof, the words "but only when it is necessary to draw one ;"

2. By adding at the end of subsection three of the said section the following words "and the cadastre number of the lot."

3. By replacing subsections 6 and 7 of the said section by the following :

"6. The astronomical course of the lines which he has drawn or verified." Id., s. 61, amended. Astronomical course of lines.

"7. The day, hour and place of observation and the method employed in ascertaining the astronomical course of such lines, if such course has been ascertained by astronomical observation ; or the day and place of observation, if such course has been ascertained by observation upon a public meridian line or other astronomical line determined upon fixed points, as hereinafter mentioned." Id., s. 61, amended. Day, &c., of observation.

9. Section 86 of the said act is amended :

1. By adding after the word "dies" in the first line of the first clause thereof the words "and when any provincial land surveyor leaves the province," Id., s. 86, amended.

2. By adding after the words "heirs" in the fourth line of the second clause thereof, the words "or to such persons as the land surveyor leaving the province may authorize for that purpose", and

3 By adding after the words " of his decease " in the fifth line of the same clause the words, " or of the absence of such land surveyor."

10. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

An Act to amend the acts respecting the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 21st June, 1883.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Section 1 of the act 43 Victoria, chapter 34, is amended by adding thereto the following :

Annual fees.

" All members of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, shall, on or before the third day of September, in each year, pay to the treasurer of the association an annual fee of two dollars."

after s. 6, of 46
V., c. 34.

2. The following section is added, after section 6 of the said act :

Member may
be sued for ar-
rears.

" 6a. In addition to being disqualified from voting under section 6, any member of the association who neglects to pay his dues and fees in arrear, after thirty days' notice sent by the secretary of the association to such member, by registered letter, may be sued for such dues and fees before any civil court of competent jurisdiction."

after s. 7 of 46
V., c. 34.

3. The following section is added after section 7 of the said act :

Term of study.

" 7a. Students of dental surgery, regularly indentured, shall study for four years in the office of a licentiate, and during such time shall attend at least one course of lectures in any medical or dental college, after which, on complying with the formalities prescribed by the by-laws of the association and on production of the certificates establishing such attendance at such medical or dental college, they shall be entitled to be admitted to examination, and upon passing such examination successfully, shall be admitted as licentiates of dental surgery ;

plomas from

Any such student, who is the holder of a diploma from any college of dental surgery recognized by the association, shall, after three years service under indentures,
