

Exemption in favor of lessees of fishing rights. Lessees of fishing rights from the Crown are exempt from the obligation imposed by this section; but no more than two persons shall be exempt under any lease, notwithstanding any arrangement that may exist with regard to the payment of rent.

Interpretation. **10.** This act shall be read and construed as though forming part of the act hereby amended; and the two so united shall be known and may be cited under the name of "The Quebec Fisheries Act."

Coming into force. **11.** This act, with the exception of the first section thereof, shall come into force on the day of its sanction, and the said first section shall come into and be in force only on and after the first day of September next.

CAP. XXVIII.

An Act to repeal section 12 of chapter 22 of the Consolidated Statutes for Lower Canada, respecting good order in and near places of public worship.
