7. As soon as certified copies of the plans and books of reference as aforesaid have been deposited in the registry office, the registrar shall prepare or amend his index to immovables in accordance with the changes effected.

C A P. XXXVII.

An Act to erect the parish of St. Joachim de Shefford into a municipality for municipal and school purposes.

[Assented to 10th June, 1884.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to erect the parish of St. Joachim de Shefford into a municipality for municipal and school purposes; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Parish of St.
Joachim de
Shefford con-
stituted a local
municipality.

1. The parish of St. Joachim de Shefford, situate in the county of Shefford, as at present canonically and civilly erected, shall constitute a local municipality working under the provisions of the municipal code and the amendments thereto, under the name of "the municipality of the parish of St. Joachim de Shefford."

Municipality
to be a local
corporation.

The said municipality, so constituted, shall be a local corporation according to the provisions of the said municipal code, under the name of "the corporation of the parish of St. Joachim de Shefford!"

The said municipality or corporation, as so constituted, shall enjoy all the powers, rights and privileges conferred upon local municipalities or corporations by the municipal code, and shall be subject to the same duties and obligations to which such municipalities or corporations are subject, as if the said municipality or corporation were mentioned in the said code. General powers.

2. The municipality, so erected, shall be separate and distinct for all municipal and school purposes. Effect of erection.

3. The first general election of councillors for the said municipality shall be held at the hour of ten in the forenoon, on the first Monday in (*) June next, in the school house of Maple Ridge, in the said municipality, and shall have the same effect as if it were held at the date mentioned in article 293 of the said code. First election of councillors.

But such election shall not have the effect of preventing the following general election from being held in accordance with article 292 of the said code, and at the date therein mentioned. Proviso as to future elections.

4. The first general election of school commissioners for the said municipality shall be held in the said school house, on the first Monday of July next, at the hour of ten in the forenoon. First election of school commissioners.

5. If, at the time of the next general elections for the legislature of Quebec, the said municipality has not yet made out an election list, the electors of the said municipality shall vote for such election at the places where they would have been entitled to vote if the present act had not been passed. Proviso, if electoral lists are not made when provincial elections are to be held.

6. Nothing contained in this act shall have the effect of relieving all or any portion of the said municipality from the debts and obligations contracted by the municipal and school corporations of Shefford and Roxton, before the passing of this act. Proviso as to existing debts of Shefford and Roxton.

7. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
