

CAP. LXXII.

An Act to amend the act incorporating the Leeds and Eastern Townships Railway Company.

[Assented to 10th June, 1884.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Leeds and Eastern Townships Railway Company has presented a petition, praying for the passing of an act to authorize it to extend its line of railway and to remove its head office ; and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition : Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Removal of head office.

1. The head office of the company shall be removed to Montreal.

Power of company to allow buildings to be erected on their property. Such buildings not bound by mortgage on company's property.

2. The company may grant to any person or corporation the right to erect warehouses, elevators or other buildings or works, for the purpose of giving greater facilities to the public, in doing business on or over the company's line or lines, on the grounds belonging to the Company, and the buildings and works so erected shall not be bound by any mortgage or lien on the property of the company without the consent of the owner of the said buildings or works.

Company may extend its line both to the east and west.

3. The company may extend its line Westwardly to such point on the Grand Trunk Railway between Lyster and Arthabaska stations, as may be found most convenient, and may also extend the line to the river St. Lawrence, at St. Pierre les Becquets, or such other point in the vicinity, as may be found most convenient, and also in an Eastwardly direction to such point on the Beauce extension of the Quebec Central Railway as may be found most convenient, provided the point of junction be north of St. George, Beauce.

Coming into force.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
