

CAP. LXXXI.

An Act respecting the Quebec Turnpike Roads.

[Assented to 10th June, 1884.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

23 V., c. 69, s. 4, amended.

Section not to apply to certain road.

1. Section 4 of the act 23 Victoria, chapter 69, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :

" This section shall not, however, apply to the road between the *Passage de Bégin* and Beaumont, mentioned in the first paragraph of section 8 of the act 16 Victoria, chapter 235."

Road to be made in conformity with 16 V., c. 235, within three years after passing of this act.

2. The said road mentioned in the first paragraph of section 8 of the act 16 Victoria, chapter 235, to wit : " the road commencing on the bank of the River St. Lawrence, opposite to the city of Quebec, at the place called the *Passage de Bégin*, and extending to the parish of Beaumont, passing by the road called *La Petite Route*, for the distance of three leagues and a-half," shall be made and completed in conformity with the act 16 Victoria, chapter 235, during the course of the three years following the passing of this act.

Trustees authorized to borrow certain amount for such purpose and to issue debentures therefor How payable.

3. The said south shore turnpike road trustees are hereby authorized to borrow a sum not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, for the purpose of completing the said portion of road, and to issue debentures for the whole or part of the said sum so borrowed, the capital and interest whereof shall be payable out of the tolls and revenues of the roads and works under the control of the said trustees, after the payment of the expenses of maintenance and management of the said roads and works.

Trustees authorized to borrow certain other sum to build bridge over Chaudière river. How payable.

4. The said trustees are authorized to borrow twenty thousand dollars for the balance of the price of building a bridge over the river Chaudière, between the parishes of St. Romuald and St. Nicholas, and for that purpose to issue debentures, the principal and interest thereof shall be payable out of the revenue of such bridge, as well as the costs of maintenance and collection.

Lieutenant-Governor to fix rates of toll.

The Lieutenant-Governor in council shall fix the rates of toll, and separate accounts shall be kept for that purpose.

Coming into force

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
