**1.** The Bar of the Province of Quebec, may, at any time after the passing of this act, admit the said Philéas A. Corriveau as an Attorney and Advocate and to practice law as such, as soon as he shall have passed the examination required by the act respecting the Bar of the said Province of Quebec.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Cyrille Hector Andgrave *alias* Handgrave dit Champagne, to the profession of attorney and advocate.

[Assented to 10th June, 1884.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS Cyrille Hector Andgrave *alias* Handgrave dit Champagne, of the parish of St. Eustache, in the county of Two Mountains, was admitted to study the profession of notary, on the twentieth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, and has followed the lectures of the Faculty of Law in Laval University, Montreal; whereas he desires to be admitted to the practice of the profession of attorney and advocate, and has prayed that an act of the Legislature of Quebec be passed to that effect; whereas the general council of the Bar has, by a resolution, passed on the fifteenth of April, 1884, declared that it gave its assent to the petitioner's application, and it is expedient to grant his prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Bar of the Province of Quebec may, at any time after the passing of this act, admit the said Cyrille Hector Andgrave *alias* Handgrave dit Champagne, to practice the profession of attorney and advocate, after he shall have passed the usual examination for admission to practice, and complied with the other conditions mentioned in the aforesaid resolution.
