An Act to amend "The Quebec General Mining Act of 1880."

[Assented to 27th May, 1882.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 49 of the Quebec General Mining Act of 1880, ^{43-44 Vic., (43-44 Victoria, chapter 12,)} is amended by substituting for the word: "twelve," in the second line the word: "seven," and by adding, at the end of the last paragraph thereof, the words: "within such radius of seven miles." ^{cap. 12, sec. 49, amended.}

2. Section 116 of the said act is amended by adding thereto after the word: "within," in the first line the following words: "a radius of seven miles from any mine that is being worked in." ^{Id. sec. 116 amended.}

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Act in force.}

C A P . X V .

An Act to amend and consolidate the Game Laws of this Province.

[Assented to 27th May, 1882.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

PROHIBITIONS.

Moose, deer, elk, caribou, &c.

1. The hunting or taking of moose, before the first of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-three, is forbidden, and, after the expiration of that period, between the first day of February and the first day of September in every subsequent year; the hunting, taking or killing of elk, caribou, deer or their fawn, is also prohibited between the first day of February and the first day of September in each year. ^{Moose. Elk, caribou, deer or their fawn.}
