An Act to amend the Act incorporating the "Canadian Electric Light Company."

[Assented to 27th May, 1882.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Canadian Electric Light Company have, by petition, prayed that their act of incorporation be amended, so that further powers be granted to them, the better to carry on the objects of their enterprise, and that power be given to them to borrow two millions of dollars, if the directors find it expedient; and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 44-45 Victoria, Quebec, chapter 69, is amended, by adding, at the end of section eleven, the following words:

Power of company to enter lands, &c., survey and take, &c., lands, &c., necessary for their purposes.

"And the company shall have the power to enter in and upon any lands or places, or innavigable river-beds, and survey, set off, take and use such part thereof as may be necessary for their purposes, and may conduct electricity through such lands by conductors, laid underground or above ground, when posts, piers and abutments shall be deemed necessary."

2. Section 16 of the same act is repealed.

3. Section 26 of the same act is amended, by striking out the words: "five hundred thousand," in the third line thereof and inserting in their stead the words: "two millions of."

Certain provisions of Quebec Railway Act incorporated with this act.

4. All the provisions of the Quebec Consolidated Railway Act, 1880, concerning expropriations, are incorporated in this act.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
