

## C A P . X C .

An act to amend the act 24 Victoria, chapter 109, to incorporate Morrin College, Quebec.

[Assented to 27th May, 1882.]

**W**HEREAS it has been represented that Morrin College, Quebec, is hindered in its usefulness and its very existence imperilled by being unable to confer degrees in Divinity upon its students, and that it would be materially assisted, in the purposes for which it was founded, if permission were granted to it to confer such degrees; and whereas, by petition, it has prayed for an amendment to its charter to that effect, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Theological Faculty of Morrin College shall have power to confer the degrees of Bachelor of Divinity and Doctor in Divinity, subject to such regulations and examinations as may be imposed by the said Faculty.

Power of Theological Faculty to confer degrees in divinity.

2. The said Theological Faculty shall have power to make by-laws and regulations, touching any matter or thing pertaining to the conditions on which the said degrees of Bachelor of Divinity and Doctor of Divinity may be conferred, whether the said degrees be such as are gained in course or by examination or such as are honorary, or whether they be conferred on matriculants of the said Morrin College or other persons, and to repeal or amend such by-laws or regulations and to make others in their stead, when and as the said Theological Faculty may see fit.

Power of same faculty to make by laws &c., for that purpose.

3. This act shall be read and construed with the said act 24 Victoria, chapter 109, hereby amended, as forming part thereof.

## C A P . X C I .

An Act to incorporate "*L'Académie des garçons de St. Joseph de Lévis.*"

[Assented to 1st May, 1882]

**W**HEREAS there has existed, for many years, at the village of Lauzon, in the parish of St. Joseph de

Lévis, a school under the direction of the "Clercs de St. Viateur," and whereas it would be advantageous to the locality that the said school be incorporated; Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Power to make by-laws, &c.

General powers of the corporation.

To acquire lands up to a certain value.

Act in force.

1. The *curé* of the parish of St. Joseph de Lévis, the school commissioners of the village of Lauzon and the acting church warden, all of them *ex-officio*, are hereby constituted a corporation under the name of "*L'Académie des garçons de St. Joseph de Lévis.*"

2. The corporation shall have power and authority to make such constitutions, rules, orders or by-laws, not contrary to this act or to the laws of this province, which they shall deem proper or necessary, in the interests of the institution and the government thereof, with power, from time to time, to modify, repeal or change the said constitutions, rules, orders or by-laws or any of them, as they may deem advisable, for the proper management of the said institution.

3. The corporation shall have perpetual succession, and may have a common seal, with power to change, alter and renew the same at their will and pleasure, and the corporation may, under the same name, contract and treat, sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, in all courts of justice and places whatsoever in this Province, and shall have power, without any other authority, to acquire, by purchase, donation or otherwise, to receive by will, hold, possess, take and accept, for the purposes of the said corporation, all lands, tenements or hereditaments and movable and immovable property, as also to sell, lease change, alienate, hypothecate and dispose of the same, and to acquire others in their place, for the purposes for which the institution was established; provided that the annual revenues of such real estate shall not exceed ten thousand dollars.

4. All property, which shall, at any time, be possessed by the said corporation, as well as the revenues arising therefrom, shall be always applied and appropriated exclusively to the purposes above mentioned.

5. The corporation shall be bound to make an annual report to the Legislature, containing a general statement of its affairs.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its saction
