

C A P . X X .

An Act to amend the Act of this Province (39 Vict., chap. 12) respecting the Internal Economy of the Legislative Assembly, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 24th July, 1880]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

S. 8, 39 Vict., chap. 12, amended.

1. Section 8 of the Act of this Province, 39 Victoria, chap. 12, is amended, by adding after the word: "legislature", in the third line of the second paragraph thereof, the following words: "or of his refusal or neglect to attend a meeting of the commission, duly convened by him or by three commissioners, in his default, or of his refusal to convene it himself, then."

Act in force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C A P . X X I .

An Act respecting the permanent employees of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of this Province.

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Commission of Leg.-Ass., and Committee on contingencies of Legislative Council, authorized to make changes in present arrangement with employees.

1. The commission, appointed under the Act of this Province, 39 Victoria, chapter 12, and the committee on contingencies of the Legislative Council, are hereby authorized to make such arrangements, as they may deem proper, subject to the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, for placing the permanent employees of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of this Province on a different footing than at present, that is to say: to arrange for paying the said employees a reduced amount of salary, and for requiring their services only for such period before, during and after each Session of the Legislature, as may be found necessary in the public interest.

Percentage to pension fund of employees, after reduction.

2. Upon such reduction being made, in addition to the salary or remuneration to be hereafter paid to the said employees, there shall be paid, for and on their behalf, by the Government, such percentage as may be necessary to enable such employees to make up the amount required
