An Act to amend the Act, 40 Victoria, chapter 21, intitled : “ An Act to amend and consolidate the Game Laws of this Province.”

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Game Laws <sup>Preamble.</sup> of this Province ; Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Act of this Province, 40 Victoria, chapter 21, is <sup>40 V., c. 21,</sup> amended, by adding after section 6, the following words :  
 “ Any person, who shoots at or kills any migratory quail <sup>Migratory quail.</sup> in this Province, before the 31st day of December, 1882, shall be liable to a fine of not more than five dollars, or an imprisonment of not more than fifteen days.

C A P . X X X .

An Act to protect toll bridges in this Province.

[Assented 24th July, 1880.]

**W**HEREAS there are toll bridges in this Province, <sup>Preamble.</sup> whose charter does not provide for their protection, in the interest of the proprietor and of the public at large, and it is important to provide therefor ; Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Every person, firm or company, being proprietor of any bridge, may cause to be posted on any such bridge, a <sup>Forbidden to go faster than at a walk.</sup> written or printed notice, in French and English, prohibiting any person from driving any vehicle faster than at a walk on such bridge.

2. Whosoever, after such notice shall have been so <sup>Fine for contra-vention and for cutting, &c., bridge.</sup> posted, drives any vehicle, faster than a walk on any such bridge, or cuts, defaces or injures any part of such bridge, or the posts or any other object forming part thereof or depending therefrom, incurs a fine, in the nature of damages, of not less than two nor more than twenty dollars, in addition to the damages caused.
