

3. All the moveable and immoveable property which now belongs to the : " Collège de Monnoir " are hereby declared to belong to the corporation of "*Le Petit Séminaire de Ste. Marie de Monnoir.*" Declaration as to property of Collège de Monnoir.

4. The Bishop of St. Hyacinthe shall, when present, have the right to vote at the proceedings of the said Council of the corporation of "*Le Petit Séminaire de Ste. Marie de Monnoir,*" at which he may preside. Right of Bishop of St. Hyacinthe to vote.

5. It shall be the duty of such corporation, to submit to the Lieutenant Governor of this province, at the end of each year, a detailed statement of the number of members of such corporation, the number of teachers employed in the different branches of instruction, the number of pupils following the course of studies therein taught, and of the moveable and immoveable properties held in virtue of the present act, and the revenues arising therefrom. Statement to be submitted to lieut. gov.

6. The bursar shall keep the register, and be responsible therefor. Register to be kept.

The council of the corporation of "*Le Petit Séminaire de Ste. Marie de Monnoir,*" shall have the right to keep minutes of its proceedings, a duly certified copy of which shall be *prima facie* evidence before any court of justice in this Province. Minutes. Copy thereof.

7. The members, composing such corporation, shall have the right to determine the number of persons who shall compose the council and the quorum thereof. Council and quorum.

8. The place of business of the said corporation shall be at the village of Marieville, in the parish of Ste. Marie de Monnoir, in the district of St. Hyacinthe. Place of business.

9. All the provisions of the act, 18 Vict., chap. 73, which are inconsistent with this act, are repealed. Inconsistent provisions of 18 V., c. 73, repealed.

10. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Act in force.

#### CAP. LXVI.

An Act to amend the statute of the Province of Canada, 28 Vict., chapter 53, intituled : " An Act to incorporate the Presbyterian College of Montreal."

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

WHEREAS petitions have been presented by the Presbyterian College of Montreal, praying for an amend- Preamble.

ment to the Act passed in the 28th year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled : " An Act to incorporate the Presbyterian College of Montreal," and it is expedient to comply with the said petitions ; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

New name-

1. The name of the corporation shall be hereafter : " The Presbyterian College, Montreal."

2. The Senate of the said " The Presbyterian College, Montreal," shall have power to confer the degree of Bachelor of Divinity, subject to such regulations and examinations as may be imposed by the said Senate, as well as to confer the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity.

3. And the said Senate shall have power to make by-laws touching any matter or thing pertaining to the conditions on which the said degrees of Bachelor of Divinity and Doctor of Divinity may be conferred ; whether the said degrees be such as are gained in course or by examinations, or such as are honorary, or whether they be conferred on matriculants of the said " The Presbyterian College, Montreal," or other persons, and such by-laws to amend, when the Senate shall see fit.

## C A P. L X V I I.

An Act to incorporate the institution called : " *Asile des Servantes Catholiques de Montréal.*"

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

Preamble-

WHEREAS there exists, at Montreal, an institution established as a home for catholic female servants ; and whereas it has been, by petition, represented that it is expedient to incorporate the said institution ; and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of such petition, Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Stéphanie Vincent, Précille Bourbonnais, Marie Gali-peau, Marguerite Coutu, Sophie Plante, all of the city of Montreal, and all other persons, who may hereafter become members of the said institution, are hereby constituted a body corporate and politic, under the name of " *Asile des Servantes Catholiques de Montréal.*"
