

CAP. LXXIII.

An Act to incorporate the Community of the Reverend Redemptorist Fathers at Ste. Anne de Beaupré.

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

WHEREAS there exists at Ste. Anne de Beaupré, a Preamble. community of Reverend Redemptorist Fathers, established under the authority of the Roman Catholic archbishop of Quebec; And whereas it has been, by petition, represented, that it is desirable to incorporate the said community; and whereas it is advisable to grant such prayer; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Reverend Fathers Jean Tielen, superior, Pierre Vander Capellen, Joseph Didier, Louis Fiévez, Alphonse Hendrickx, Servais Paquay, and all persons who may, hereafter, become members of the said community, are constituted a body politic and corporate, under the name of: "The Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, at Ste. Anne de Beaupré;" and the said corporation shall have perpetual succession and a common seal, and may, for the purposes and requirements of the House of the said community, acquire, hold, possess, accept and receive any moveable or immoveable property whatsoever, both those which the community already owns as well as those which may be sold, ceded, given left by will to it, and to sell and lease the same and acquire others in lieu thereof, for the said purposes; provided that the annual revenue of such immovable property does not exceed the sum of four thousand dollars.

2. The said corporation shall have full power and authority, from time to time, to make by-laws and regulations, (not contrary to the present act or to the laws in force in this province), for the government of the said corporation, for the admission of persons into the said community, and the removal of the same, and to amend such by-laws and regulations.

3. The present act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
