An Act to incorporate the Association known as: "The Quebec Garrison Club."

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

**W**HEREAS there exists in the city of Quebec, an association known as: "The Quebec Garrison Club," established for the physical and mental recreation of its members; and whereas the ordinary members of the said association have, by petition, prayed to be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant their petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Preamble.

**1.** Theodore J. Duchesnay, Joseph Bell Forsyth, Richard Alleyn, J. B. Amyot, Frost Wood Gray, G. F. Arthur Evan-turel, J. F. Turnbull, Thomas Roy, and such other persons as are now ordinary members, or shall hereafter become ordinary members of the said association, under the constitution, rules and regulations thereof, are hereby, for the above purposes, constituted a body politic and corporate by the name of: "The Quebec Garrison Club," and such corporation shall, from time to time, and at all times hereafter, be able and capable to purchase, acquire, hold, possess and enjoy, and to have, exchange, take and receive lands, tenements and hereditaments and real or immovable estate, being and situate in the city of Quebec or its vicinity, necessary for the permanent use and occupation of the said corporation, for the purpose for which they are incorporated, and the said property to hypothecate, sell, alienate and dispose of, and to acquire other instead thereof, for the same purposes, whensoever the said corporation may deem it proper so to do; but such real estate shall not exceed the annual value of four thousand dollars.

**2.** The constitution, rules and regulations now in force, touching the admission and expulsion of members, and the management and conduct generally of the affairs and concerns of the said association, in so far as they are not inconsistent with the laws of this Province, shall be the constitution, rules and regulations of the said corporation; provided always that the said corporation may, from time to time, alter, repeal and change, in whole or in part, such constitution, rules and regulations, in the manner provided by the constitution, rules and regulations of the said corporation.

Members, not personally responsible.

3. No member of the corporation shall be liable for any of the debts thereof.

Employment of revenues.

4. The rents, revenues and profits, arising out of every description of moveable and immoveable property, belonging to the said corporation, shall be appropriated and employed to the exclusive use of the said corporation, in the construction and repair of the buildings, required for the purposes of the said corporation, and in the payment of expenses legitimately incurred in carrying out any of the objects relating to the aforesaid purposes.

Return to legislature.

5. The said corporation shall be bound to submit a report of its affairs to the legislature, every year, within twenty days after the opening of the session.

Act in force.

6. This Act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

An act to incorporate "*L'Union des Commis-Marchands de la Cité de Montréal.*"

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS there has existed, for several years, in the city of Montreal, an association known under the name of: "*L'Union des commis-marchands de la cité de Montréal,*" the object of which is to aid and assist its members in case of sickness, and to secure similar assistance and other benefits to the widows or heirs of deceased members; and whereas the members of the said association have, by petition, prayed that it be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Persons incorporated.

1. The following persons, namely: O. A. Barette, D. Perrault, Jos. Ethier, F. C. Barette, N. Sevigny, J. A. Donais, J. Léon Dozois, S. Gauthier, J. T. Bourcier, D. Lanthier, F. P. Dupuis, G. N. Ducharme, Nap. Tousignant, S. Prieur, L. Houle, Arthur Gagnon, Wilfrid Thibeault, and such other persons as are now members of such association or who hereafter may become members thereof, in virtue of the provisions of this act, are hereby constituted a corporation and body politic, under the name of "*L'Union des commis-marchands de la cité de Montréal,* and under such name may, at any time hereafter, acquire, possess, hold,
