

standing that, in his act of birth, his christian names are as follows: "Louis Thomas Godfroi"; and whereas certain inconvenience may result to the said Louis Philippe Pelletier, from the fact that the said Christian names are not the same in certain public or other deeds; and whereas, in order to remedy such inconveniences, the said Louis Philippe Pelletier has, by his said petition, prayed for the passing of an act, and whereas it is expedient to grant his prayer: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The name of the said Louis Philippe Pelletier is hereby confirmed, and declared to have been and to be, as so written, his true name, and under such name he may sue and be sued, claim, exercise and possess all advantages, benefits, rights, privileges and titles, inheritances, legacies and gifts, which may have been or may be given him, or may have belonged or shall belong to him, even if his said Christian names have not been written in the same manner; and all deeds, purchases, agreements, writings and documents, made or passed by him, or in his favor, under such name, shall bind him, and shall bind others towards him; and the said Christian names are declared to be his true Christian names to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

An Act to declare and confirm the name of Joseph Eloi de Gagné, of the parish of Les Eboulements, Esquire, Merchant, and for the relief of his descendants.

[Assented to 24th July, 1880.]

WHEREAS Joseph Eloi de Gagné, of the parish of Les Eboulements, county of Charlevoix, esquire, merchant, has, by his petition, represented that, for a great number of years, he has been known under the name of Joseph Eloi de Gagné, and that his name has been so entered in a great number of registers and other public documents, and in a great number of deeds, and other authentic, and private writings, and that his said family name has been so transmitted to his children, notwithstanding that in his act of birth the name of his father is spelt: *Desgagner*, and his christian names are spelt: *Joseph Eloy*; and whereas certain inconvenience may result to the said Joseph Eloi de Gagné, or to his descendants, from the fact that the said

family name has been written with a different orthography in certain public or other deeds ; and whereas, in order to remedy such inconveniences, the said Joseph Eloi de Gagné, has, by his said petition, prayed for the passing of an act, and whereas it is expedient to grant his prayer ; Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The name of the said Joseph Eloi de Gagné is hereby confirmed, and declared to have been and to be, as so written, his true name, and under such name he may sue and be sued, claim, exercise and possess all advantages, benefits, rights, privileges and titles, inheritances, legacies and gifts, which may have been or may be given him, or may have belonged or shall belong to him, even if his name has been otherwise written therein ; and all deeds, purchases, agreements, writings and documents, made or passed by him, or in his favor, under such name, or under any other name, shall bind him, and shall bind others towards him ; and the said family name is also confirmed in the same manner for his children, and declared to be the true name of his family.

Pending cases.

2. If any suits or proceedings have been commenced by or against the said Joseph Eloi de Gagné, under such name, as thus or otherwise written, they shall not be affected by this act, but may be continued, until after judgment, execution, satisfaction and discharge, in the same manner as if the present act had not been passed.

Act in force.

3. The present act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
