

C A P. L X X I X.

An act to authorize the board of examiners for the examination of candidates for admission to practice as land surveyors in Lower-Canada (province of Quebec), to admit, after examination, William Crawford to practice as a land surveyor.

[*Assented to 28th December, 1876.*]

WHEREAS William Crawford, of the City of Montreal, ^{Preamble.} civil engineer, after following the prescribed course, received from the university of McGill College, in Montreal, a degree or diploma of qualification as a civil engineer and land surveyor, and immediately afterwards left this province and was for many years engaged in foreign countries in the laying out and construction of railways; and whereas the said William Crawford has passed the requisite preliminary examinations required by law to qualify him to act as an apprentice to a land surveyor for Lower Canada (province of Quebec) although he did not serve for one year as such apprentice to a provincial land surveyor as required by law, owing to his absence as aforesaid; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful for the board of examiners for the ^{Admission} examination of candidates for admission to practice as ^{authorized,} land surveyors in Lower Canada (province of Quebec), at their next meeting or at any time, to admit the said William Crawford to practice as a provincial land surveyor, after the passing by him of the usual examination, and to grant him the usual diploma.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Act in force,} sanction.
