

quirements of law in such case for such safeguard; and to that end, the said council may purchase or accept in gift or otherwise, on such terms as the council may deem proper, any piece or lot of ground in the said new chief-place (*chef-lieu*); the whole in accordance with, and subject to articles 512, 513, 514, 515, 516 and 517 of the said municipal code of the province of Quebec, all which, in so far as may be compatible with this act, shall remain in full force in this behalf.

3. Whenever a suitable and sufficient building, with fire-proof vault as aforesaid, shall have been constructed as authorized by this act, it shall be competent for the lieutenant-governor in council of this province, to establish by proclamation in ordinary course, the registry office of and for the said county of Ottawa, in the said new chief-place (*chef-lieu*), at present known as the village of Hull, on and from a day certain to be appointed in such proclamation; and all registrations required by law to be made in the registry office of the said county shall be, thenceforth, there made; and all the books, deeds, documents, maps, plans, papers, and all other property belonging to the said office, shall be then forthwith moved from the village of Aylmer, to such new registry office in the village of Hull aforesaid, the whole according to law.

When suitable building has been provided registry office to be at Hull after proclamation.

C A P. X X X I I .

An Act to change the name of the Registration Division of Dorchester Number Two, and the locality, where the Registry Office of the said division shall be kept.

[Assented to 24th December, 1872.]

WHEREAS it is desirable, that the registration division, now known as the registration division of Dorchester number two, should hereafter be called the registration division of the County of Levis, and whereas the removal of the registry office thereof to the town of Levis, would greatly facilitate proper registration; Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Preamble.

1. From and after the passing of this act, the registration division of Dorchester number two, shall cease to bear that name, and shall be called and known as "the registration division of the county of Levis," but such change of name shall in no respect affect the appointment of the present registrar.
