

CAP. V.

An Act to continue for a limited time the several Acts therein mentioned.

[Assented to 24th December, 1870.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS, it is expedient to continue, for a limited time, the acts hereinafter mentioned, which would otherwise expire at the end of the present session; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Acts of Lower
Canada, 2 Geo.
4, c. 8.,

1. The act of the parliament of the late province of Lower Canada, passed in the second year of the reign of his late majesty King George the Fourth, intituled: "An act for better regulating the common of the Seigneurie of Laprairie de la Magdeleine;" the act of the said parliament passed in the same year of the same reign, and intituled: "An act to

enable the inhabitants of the Seigneurie of La Baie St. Antoine, commonly called La Baie du Febvre, to provide for the better regulation of the common of the said seigneurie," as amended and extended by the act of the said parliament, passed in the fourth year of the same reign, and intituled:

4 Geo. 4, c. 26,

"An act to authorize the chairman and trustees of the common of the Seigneurie of the Bay St. Antoine, commonly called the Baie du Febvre, to terminate certain disputes relating to the limits of the said common and for other purposes appertaining to the same;" the act of the said parliament, passed in the ninth year of the same reign, and

intituled: "An act to alter and amend an act passed in the sixth year of His Majesty's reign, and intituled: "An act to authorize the inhabitants of the fief Grosbois, in the county of St. Maurice, to make regulations for the common of the said fief," and all and every of the said acts are hereby continued, and shall remain in force until the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, and from thence until the end of the then next ensuing session of the legislature, and no longer.

Proviso as to
acts of the
present session.

2. Provided always, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the effect of any act passed during the present session, repealing, amending, rendering permanent, or continuing to any further period than that herein appointed, any of the acts hereinbefore mentioned and continued, nor shall continue any provision or part of any of the acts in this act mentioned, which may have been repealed by any act passed in any previous session or during the present session.
