

## CAP. II.

An Act to amend the Stamps' regulation act.

[Assented to 1st February, 1870.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Lieut.-Gov. in Council may call in certain stamps and issue others.

1. The lieutenant-governor may from time to time, by order in council, provide, that on and after such day as may be therein named, and after at least one month's notice given by proclamation in the Quebec Official Gazette, all and any stamps, or all stamps of any one or more values or denominations, or forms and patterns, in such order and proclamation designated, shall cease to be stamps, or to be issued or received or avail as stamps, and by such order and proclamation may provide for the calling in and cancelment thereof, and for the procuring and issuing instead thereof, and the exchanging thereof, of other stamps of like or other value, or denomination, or form, or pattern in such order and proclamation designated; and all the provisions of the stamps' regulation act, shall, on and after such day, apply to all stamps issued in terms of such order and proclamation, to all intents as theretofore, to the stamps thereby called in; and all provisions whatever of such order and proclamation in anywise relative to such calling in, cancelment, procuring, issue or exchange aforesaid, shall have force in law, to all intents as though herein expressly set forth and enacted.

This act to form part of the Stamps' regulation act.

2. The stamps' regulation act and this act shall be read together as one act, and shall be sufficiently cited as "the Stamps' regulation act."

## CAP. III.

An Act respecting the issuing of Licenses.

[Assented to 1st February, 1870.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Lieut.-Gov. in Council may appoint persons to sign or issue licenses.

1. The lieutenant-governor in council may, from time to time, appoint and authorize any person or persons to sign or to issue any licenses on which any duty or sum of money is payable to or for the benefit of the province, and may in like manner determine the times, manner and form in which such licenses shall be issued.
