

to the exercise of their ministry, and all vehicles and animals actually being used by them, in so going or returning, shall pass toll free through every turnpike or toll-gate on any turnpike-road or bridge through which they may have occasion to pass, whether such turnpike-road or bridge and the tolls thereon belong to the province or to any local or municipal authority, or body of trustees or commissioners for local purposes, or to any incorporated or unincorporated company, or to any other body or person their duties may pass toll free on all turnpike-roads and bridges.

## C A P . X X X V .

An Act to amend the Colonization Railway Aid Act of 1869.

[Assented to 1st February, 1870.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The eighth section of the colonization railway aid act of 1869, is hereby amended, by substituting for the word "seventy" therein, the words "seventy-two," and for the words "seventy-three," the words "seventy-five." Sec. 8, Colonization railway aid act of 1869, amended.

2. The Montreal northern colonization railway company shall be entitled, upon its conforming to the provisions of the said act, to the aid assured by the said act, notwithstanding that the whole, or any part of the road of the said company shall have been constructed in iron. Mont. North. Col. Railway, entitled to aid, although built of iron.

## C A P . X X X V I .

An Act to protect Forests against Fires.

[Assented to 1st February, 1870.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. No person shall, at any time, set fire to or cause to burn, any tree, shrub or other plant, growing or standing in any forest, or at a distance of less than one mile from any forest. Setting fire to a tree in a forest, &c., forbidden.

2. No person shall set fire to or cause to burn any pile of wood, branches or brushwood, or any tree, shrub or other plant, which shall have been felled in the forest or at any distance less than a mile from the forest, except for the purpose of clearing lands between the first day of September and the first day of July. Burning of piles of wood forbidden, except for clearing lands, between 1st Sept. and 25th June.
