

of draught are not harnessed abreast, then and in such case the left runner shall run in the track of such horse, horses, or other beasts of draught."

Counties to which amendment shall apply.

2. The preceding provisions shall come into force, within the counties of Huntingdon, Beauharnais, Chateauguay, Laprairie, Napierville, St. Jean, Missisquoi, Iberville, Shefford, Brome, Stanstead, Compton, and Argenteuil, on the first day of December, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine.

Persons residing in other counties may travel as they please.

3. Nevertheless all persons residing in any county in which the provisions of the first section of this act shall not be in force, may travel wheresoever they please, without being bound to conform themselves to the requirements of the said first section of this act.

Penalty for contravention etc.; recovery thereof.

4. Any person contravening the provisions of this act shall incur for each such offence a penalty of one dollar, so soon as he shall have been convicted thereof, before any justice of the peace for the district, upon the oath of one credible witness other than the informer; and if such penalty be not at once paid, together with the costs of suit, such justice of the peace may cause the amount thereof to be levied by the seizure and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender, by warrant under his hand, or cause the offender to be committed to the common gaol of the district, for any period not exceeding eight days.

Appropriation of penalties.

5. One moiety of the penalties, recovered under the authority of this act, shall be paid over to the treasurer of the province, and shall belong to her majesty, for the public uses of the province, and the other moiety shall belong to and be paid over to the informer.

CAP XXXV.

An Act to repeal chapter thirty-two of the consolidated statutes for Lower Canada, respecting the destruction of Wolves.

[Assented to 5th April, 1869.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:
