

C A P. L V I I .

An Act to remove doubts as to and better define the limits of the municipality of Portage du Fort, Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 21st March, 1889.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. All the islands in the river Ottawa, belonging to the Province of Quebec, lying in front of the territory forming the municipality of the village of Portage du Fort, being lots 29, 30, 31 and 32 of the 1st range of the township of Litchfield, are declared to be included in the said village municipality.

Certain islands in Ottawa river included in village of Portage du Fort.

C A P. L V I I I .

An Act to amend the act 24 Victoria, chapter 26, intituled :
" An Act to amend and consolidate the laws respecting the Recorder's Court of the city of Quebec."

[Assented to 21st March, 1889.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Subsection 2 of section 6 of the act 24 Victoria, chapter 26, is amended by adding after the words " less than " in the first line thereof, the following words " two thousand five hundred dollars."

C A P. L I X .

An act to erect into a separate municipality, the North-West portion of the municipality of the village of Cote-des-Neiges-West.

[Assented to 21st March, 1889.]

WHEREAS the great majority of the rate-payers of the North-West portion of the municipality of the village of Cote-des-Neiges have prayed for the erection

of the said territory into a distinct and separate municipality, on the ground that the property comprised in such territory is occupied for agricultural purposes, and consequently the requirements and interests of the inhabitants of that portion of the said municipality are different from those of the other portion :

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Certain territory constituted a distinct and separate village municipality.

1. The North-West portion of the present municipality of the village of Cote-des-Neiges, which extends from the division line between the properties designated under the numbers one hundred and twenty-one, (121), and one hundred and twenty-two, (122), of the official cadastre of the said village of Cote-des-Neiges, and from the centre of the road, known as "Saint Catherine road", to the North West limits of the said municipality of the village of Cote-des-Neiges, is constituted a distinct and separate village municipality, under the name of "the municipality of the village of Notre Dame des Neiges West," as if it had been so constituted under the provisions of the Municipal Code.

2. The inhabitants and rate-payers of the said municipality shall constitute a corporation, under the name of "the corporation of the village of Notre Dame des Neiges West."

Proviso for repartition of school taxes while town of Notre Dame des Neiges and village of Notre Dame des Neiges West form one school municipality.

3. So long as the town of Notre Dame des Neiges and the village of Notre Dame des Neiges West shall form one school municipality, the funds required by the school commissioners for the present municipality of the village of Côte des Neiges shall be levied upon the respective immoveable property of the said new municipalities, in proportion to the actual value of the said immoveable property, according to the valuation actually in force.

Corporation not to pass by-law preventing use of Côte des Neiges stream.

4. The corporation of the village of Notre Dame des Neiges West shall not pass any by-law to prevent the proprietors of industrial establishments of the town of Notre Dame des Neiges from using as in the past the waters of the Côte des Neiges ditch or stream.

Coming into force.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
