CAP. CIX.

An Act to authorize the institutes and curators under the substitutions created by the wills of the late Thomas Durocher and Marie Coulombe to sell and dispose of certain substituted immoveables.

[Assented to 21st March, 1889.]

Preamble

WHEREAS Thomas Durocher and Marie Coulombe, his wife, in their lifetime of the city of Montreal, did substitute their property by their respective wills, made in notarial form, at Montreal, on the twenty fourth September, one thousand eight hundred and sixty;

Whereas the immoveables subject to such substitutions are number 303 of the official cadastre of Saint Louis Ward, and number 828 of the official cadastre of Saint Lawrence Ward, in the city of Montreal;

Whereas the expropriation which is to be made for the widening of Saint Lawrence street, in the city of Montreal, will absorb the greater portion of the immoveable lastly above designated, and the remainder thereof will not be large enough to erect buildings thereon for any useful purpose, in view of its situation;

Whereas the institutes under the said substitutions have, by petition, prayed that they, the curators to absent institutes and the curators to the substitutions, be authorized to sell and dispose of the said substituted property, as the sole means of retaining the price and value thereof for the substitutes, and it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

The institutes, assisted by the curators to the substitutions created by the wills of the late Thomas Durocher and Dame Marie Coulombe, respectively made on the 24th September, 1860, in the city of Montreal, before L. S. Martin and his colleague, notaries, are hereby authorized to sell, abandon, transfer and dispose of the immoveable property above described, subject to the said substitutions, by com-
