

CAP. CXVII.

An Act authorizing William S. Cotton dental surgeon, to practise in the Province of Quebec, and authorizing and ordering the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec to grant him a certificate as licentiate of dental Surgery.

[Assented to 21st March, 1889.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS William S. Cotton, of Cowansville, in the district of Bedford, has, by his petition, represented that after a regular course of study in an incorporated college of dental surgery, to wit: The Boston Dental College, in the city of Boston, in the State of Massachusetts, one of the United States of America, he was granted a license and diploma of Doctor of Dental Surgery by said college in the year 1886;

Whereas the said William S. Cotton has omitted to be first admitted to study by the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, and is exposed to suffer from that omission;

Whereas the said William S. Cotton is represented as possessing the required professional knowledge and skill as such dentist; and it is expedient to grant his said petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Dental Association authorized to grant W. S. Cotton a license to practice.

1. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is authorized, through its proper officers to grant to the said William S. Cotton a certificate as a Licentiate of Dental Surgery of this Province and admitting him as member of the said Dental Association, and to all the rights and privileges enjoyed by the members thereof, upon payment of the usual fee therefor, as soon as the said William S. Cotton shall have passed the examination required by the law concerning dentists as contained in section 14 of the Statutes of Quebec, 37 Victoria, chapter 14.

Coming into force.

2. The present act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
