

## CAP. CXVIII.

An Act authorizing Alexander A. Graham, dental surgeon, to practise in the Province of Quebec, and authorizing and ordering the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec to grant him a certificate as a licentiate of Dental Surgery.

[Assented to 21st March, 1889.]

**W**HEREAS Alexander A. Graham, of Granby, in the dis-<sup>Preamble.</sup>trict of Bedford, has, by his petition, represented that, after a regular course of study in an incorporated college of dental surgery, to wit: in the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Ontario, in the city of Toronto, in the said Province of Ontario, he was granted a license and diploma as a licentiate of dental surgery, by the said college, on the tenth day of March 1882, and was actually practising as such dentist at said Granby, at the time of the passing of the Act of the Legislature of this Province, 46 Victoria, Chapter 34, intituled; "An Act to amend and consolidate the laws incorporating The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec."

Whereas the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec had not then and has not now established any college, nor was there then nor is there now any college of dentistry in this Province, where students can study the said profession of dentist, and the said Alexander A. Graham has had to have recourse to the colleges of other countries for that purpose, but had omitted to be first admitted to study by the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, and is exposed to suffer from that omission;

Whereas the said Alexander A. Graham is represented as possessing the required professional knowledge and skill as such dentist; and it is expedient to grant his said petition; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The said Alexander A. Graham is and has been <sup>A. A. Graham.</sup> since the date of his license and diploma from the Royal <sup>declared to be</sup> College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Ontario, <sup>entitled to</sup> a duly qualified dental surgeon entitled to practise his <sup>practise as a</sup> said profession of dentist in this Province. <sup>dentist.</sup>

2. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is <sup>Dental asso-</sup> hereby authorized through its proper officers to grant said <sup>ciation autho-</sup> Alexander A. Graham a certificate as a licentiate of den- <sup>rized to grant</sup> tal surgery of this Province, and admitting him as a <sup>him license to</sup> <sup>practise.</sup>

member of the said Dental Association, and to all the rights and privileges enjoyed by the members thereof, upon payment of the usual fee therefor.

Should the said Association refuse or neglect to deliver to the said Alexander A. Graham such certificate within three months after demand therefor has been duly made, then and in that case, the said Alexander A. Graham may thereafter practise dental surgery in the Province as fully and as legally as if he was a member of said Dental Association.

**3.** The present act will not affect pending cases, and shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
